



Volunteer Vaccine FAQ

When do I need to be vaccinated by?

All on-site volunteers must show proof of vaccination by Tuesday, February 1, 2022.

I want to get vaccinated, but I don't know where to start.

Visit www.vaccines.gov to find a vaccination site near you and schedule your first dose - it's FREE for everyone!

I have a medical/religious exemption. Can I still volunteer?

Yes, New Horizons has several ways to get involved that do not require being on-site for longer than 15 minutes such as hosting your own donation drive, dropping off hot meals, or making in-kind gifts. Which volunteers does this vaccine requirement apply to?

Only volunteers whose commitment requires them to be on-site for longer than 15 minutes such as cooking and serving in the New Horizons kitchen or volunteers working directly in the shelter.

Why do I need to show proof of vaccination?

New Horizons is an agency that partners with the City of Seattle and King County. Both have required partners to comply with a vaccine mandate for all staff and volunteers.

Can I just show a picture of my vaccine card?

Yes! Originals, copies, or photographs on a mobile device all count as acceptable proof.
